

Special Note: You need to be proficient in ALL four number operations in both fractions AND decimals in order to be able to pass each level! And, in order to pass each section, you *must* pass *two* out of every three of the questions. A good strategy is to do the TWO that you are absolutely positive that you CAN do, skip to the next section, then come BACK and do the ones you skipped at the end.
